

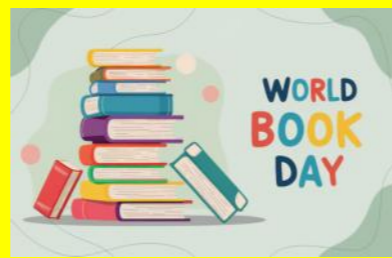

### World Book Day

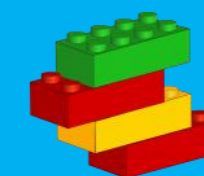
