Impact on SEND Pupils

- 1. IEPs are allowing for smaller steps of progress to be celebrated.
- 2. Adaptive teaching/groupings is providing positive role models for SEND children and encouraging more engagement in lessons.
- 3. SLT and NELI in Year R is having a good impact on SLCN as this is our biggest area of need.
- 4. Small group interventions such as Attention Autism are having a direct impact on progress towards outcomes and IEPS for children on Wave 4 and 5.
